Hot Weather is Here for a While!

We are experience summer here in Northeast Ohio in all of it's glory. 90+ temps will sure take it's toll on man and machine. Besides the usual advice of staying hydrated and wearing sunscreen, there are some things to watch out for in the hot temps.

- Density Altitude—Many weather services will declare the altitude as calculated by the temperature and humidity throughout the day. Watch out for this to climb during very hot days. This will effect the performance of the aircraft adversely. You may not have a problem getting out of that short field on a cool day or early in the morning, but it's a different story in the afternoon sun. Know what your plane can do.
- Thunderstorms—Hot weather is a breading ground for these and they can pop up without much warning. Besides the rain, strong winds can knock you around even if you are not that close to them. Our light aircraft are especially vulnerable.
- Carb Ice—The dew point can cause ice to build up on the inside of the carb. Yes, even on a summer day. This will usually show up as soon as you are starting to reduce power and close the carb slide. Be aware of the dew point and know how to get yourself out of a problem by looking for warmer air.
- Humidity—This can cause wood parts to swell and change shape. Do you have a wood propeller? Having the airfoil change shape can effect your power in climb and cruise.
- Warm Weather and Gas—Gas cans can swell in the heat of the summer day. The heat will actually cause the fuel to expand and take up more room. In some cases, it may rob performance from your engine and require the engine to be re-jetted to perform better. GA guys can just adjust the mixture but our ultralight engines need to have the jets changed in extreme

cases. As this can be a hassle to perform, you will need to make sure it is something that is worth your effort. Your manufacture has charts to help you decide which jets fit your conditions.

Take the time to plan your flight in hot weather and remember that you may be able to get into that small, local airport, but getting out may be more of a challenge.
