Orvil and Wilbur Wright to Appear at Next Meeting

Mr. Wilbur Wright and Mr. Orville Wright of Dayton, Ohio, will present results from their experiments concerning the development of a practical, piloted, flying machine. The experiments were conducted between 1899 and 1905, at Kitty Hawk, North Carolina and Dayton, Ohio. They will explain and demonstrate many of the technical aspects of their invention by using models and actual photographs of the experiments. The unique flight control system will be discussed in some detail, along with the propulsion system, and supporting wind tunnel experiments.

Wilbur Wright will be presented by Tom Benson who is an aeronautical engineer in the Turbo-machinery and Propulsion Systems Division at the NASA Glenn Research Center. Tom currently works on a number of educational outreach activities at the center, including the development of the agency's Beginner's Guide to Aeronautics and Re-Living the Wright Way web sites for the Educational Programs Office (EPO). Orville Wright will be presented by Roger Storm who is the director of the Digital Learning Network (DLN) at NASA Glenn. Roger retired from the Chemistry Department at Fairview High School and was a frequent summer teacher intern at NASA Glenn for the EPO. Roger developed an educational activity booklet for EPO built around the experiences of the Wright brothers. Tom and Roger teach classes for the DLN that include Flight in Earth's Sky, Simple Machines, Our Planet Earth and Rocket Science.



This special meeting with the Wright Brothers will be a big one, so we eat at 6 pm from the Buffet.

Buffet will have: Meatloaf, Chicken Breast, Whitefish, Mashed & Parley Potatoes, Veg, Tossed salad, Beverage.

Cost is \$15.75 a person and includes Tax and Gratuity.
